

## Warwick Figure Skaters Annual Show March 31, 2012 Information and Application

Every year, the Warwick Figure Skaters present their annual ice show so that our skaters can demonstrate to their family and friends all of their skating accomplishments. The following information will be especially helpful to our many new members and a refresher for members who have performed in previous shows. The shows will be held Saturday, March 31, 2012 at 1:00 pm and 7:00 pm (each show will last approximately 3 hours). Each skater will be in both performances for their group(s).

To be eligible for the show you must have purchased a Basics, Basics Freestyle, Basic Dance, or Above Basics session in the Fall/Winter 2011/2012 season (unless for a Graduation Senior Number).

### **Basic Skills Skaters:**

Having met all other criteria, each Basic Skills skater is eligible to skate in a Basic Skills group and/or a Basic Dance group, based on the sessions purchased for the Fall/Winter 2011/2012 season.

### **Above Basics Skaters:**

Having met all other criteria, Above Basics Skaters are eligible to skate in as many groups as they qualify for based on the criteria below.

- Freestyle Group – Must have passed Basic Skills Freeskate 4, and purchased a session that allowed Freestyle, for the Fall/Winter 2011/2012 session. These groups will be grouped primarily on test level.
- Dance Group – Must have passed Basic Dance badge 6, and purchased a session that allowed Dance, for the Fall/Winter 2011/2012 session. These groups will be grouped primarily on test level.
- Competitor's group – Must have medaled in 3 out of 5 Non-Basics competitions or medaled at the 2011 Little New England's (in the Final Round). Medals for Element Only Competitions and Basic Skills Competitions do not count.
- Graduating Senior Number – The only requirement for this group is that the skater be a graduating High School Senior and be a current Member with Warwick Figure Skaters.

**Practices:** Show practices will begin after the conclusion of Basic Skills sessions in March 2012. There will be 3 practices for each group. Please make every effort to attend all 3. Notices will be posted on the bulletin boards to let skaters know the show number and group to which they are assigned and the practice schedule.

**Mandatory Dress Rehearsal:** Will be held on Friday March 30, 2012. They will be 4:00-5:00 pm for soloists only, 5:00-6:00 pm for 1st half numbers, and 6:30 - 8:00 pm for 2nd half numbers. Times are approximate, and subject to change without notice.

### **Tickets, Programs, Flowers:**

One parent pass per family will be provided that can be used at both shows. Parent Passes and tickets will be available at Dress Rehearsal. Tickets, programs, and flowers will be available at each show.
