

Warwick Figure Skaters Coaching Requirements

Effective July 1, 2010

Approved By Warwick Figure Skaters Board of Governors June 21, 2010

General Requirements:

- Must be 18 Years of age or a High School Graduate
- There must be a need for additional coaches
- CPR and First Aid recommended not required
- Proof of Liability Insurance \$1,000,000
- Must be a U.S. Figure Skating Register Coach
- Must be a member of the Professional Skaters Association.

Test Requirements:

- To teach Basics: Intermediate Freestyle or Certified PSA Rating
- To teach Freestyle: Novice or Senior PSA Rating.
- To teach Moves in the Field: Junior Moves or Senior PSA Rating. Must be USFS C.E.R. certified class A or B.
- To teach Dance: Pre-Gold Dance, Adult Gold Dance or Senior PSA Rating, unless the applicant serves a club need (Partner). Must be USFS C.E.R. certified class A or B.

Grandfathering:

- Anyone that was an approved WFS coach(Active or Inactive), prior to June 30, 2010, is grandfathered in and exempted from test requirement changes, but not the C.E.R requirement.

Note: WFS is not accepting applications for Basic Skills, unless the applicant is applying for Dance or Freestyle. Also, WFS reserves the right to reject a candidate that does not appear to be a good fit for Warwick Figure Skaters.
