3. If a bank returns a check to us, a \$25.00 fee will be added to your bill. Second offense will result in an additional \$25.00 fee and only bank checks or money orders will be accepted thereafter.
4. All prior balances must be paid in full before the Fall/Winter application will be accepted. **All Fall/Winter final payments must be made by 2/1/10. Any skater who has a balance on their account as of March 1, 2010, will not be allowed to skate in the W.F. S. Annual Show.**
5. Balances that are not paid within a reasonable time will be forwarded to U.S.F.S. with the name of the skater as a member not in good standing. Member will not be able to test or compete until their name is removed from the list. This applies to Full Members and Associate Members.
6. Sessions may be changed or canceled by the Board of Governors due to lack of enrollment.
7. Sessions may be changed or canceled due to testing, special events, weather, or technical problems at the rink. Club information will be posted on the bulletin boards near the entrances to the rinks. Also, updates will be posted on the WFS web site, www.warwickfs.org. Check often for new info!
8. Music/Monitor fees are mandatory on all ice bills, except Basics. These times are assigned on a first come, first serve basis.
