Above Basics Information and Application

Every year the Warwick Figure Skaters presents their annual ice show so that our skaters can demonstrate to their family and friends all of their skating accomplishments. The following information will be especially helpful to our many new members and a refresher for previous members.

Skaters will be grouped by test level and age, and may be combined with other levels. One or two Professionals will be assigned to choreograph each group number.

All skaters will be asked to visit The Competitors Closet to be properly measured and fitted for their costumes.

To be eligible for the show you must have purchased a Freestyle or Dance session through the Warwick Figure Skaters for the 2009-2010 season and return this application prior to the deadline.

Prices: **\$80.00** Early Registration the first show number for the **1st skater** in a family
\$120.00 Late Registration for the first show number for the **1st skater** in a family
\$60.00 For the first show number for **each additional skater** in a family
\$40.00 For **each additional number** for all skaters

The above price includes costumes, ice time fees and Professional fees.

One parent pass per family will also be provided.

Tights and other accessories may need to be purchased separately.

Practices: **When basics lessons end, show practices will begin. There will be 3 practices for each group. Please make every effort to attend all 3.** Notices will be posted on the bulletin boards to let skaters know the show number they are assigned and the practice schedule.

Mandatory Dress Rehearsal will be held on Friday March 26, 2010

Times are approximate, and subject to change without notice.

4:00-5:00 pm **soloists only**

5:00-6:00 pm 1st half numbers

6:00-7:00 pm 2nd half numbers

Shows: **Saturday March, 27, 2010 at 1 pm and 7 pm** (*each show will last approximately 3 hours.*)

Each skater will be in both performances for their group(s).

In late February please start checking bulletin boards for times and dates of the practices.

Tickets: Will be available at the dress rehearsal and at the door prior to each show.
