Warwick Figure Skaters (WFS) is a non-profit organization that serves skaters, parents and skating-lovers from age 4 through adult, in our Basic Skills Learn-to-Skate program all the way through advanced programs of instruction. Lessons are offered year-round during three different ice seasons at two local Warwick Municipal rinks – Thayer Memorial Arena and Warburton Arena. We offer instruction in Basic Skills, Moves in the Field, Freestyle, Ice Dancing and Synchronized Team skating as well as off-ice conditioning classes.

1. **Equipment needed for the Basic Skills Program** are good fitting leather skates (no double runners; figure skates preferred), blade guards, helmets for beginners (good fitting bicycle helmets are acceptable), mittens and layers (rather than bulky clothing) are recommended. **Quality used skates are a good buy, and WFS will have some available for purchase at the Open Registration on September 25, 2010 (10:00 am – 12:00 pm, Thayer Arena, Sandy Lane, Warwick).** If you are renting skates, be sure to plan ahead.
2. Private lessons during Basics Skills Programs Open Skate are available by contracting with a professional coach. Inquire at the sign-in desk and our Basics Coordinator will introduce you to our professionals.
3. Information and qualifications of skating professionals are available on our web site, www.warwickfs.org, or from the Pro Liaison, Kim Ferguson, kkferg@cox.net.
4. All skaters must be active USFS skaters in good standing. New skaters and skaters with inactive USFS memberships must select one of the membership options on page 3. If you are unsure of the status of your membership, you may request your status from Julie Cyr. Please include your first name, last name and USFS number in an email to jacirc3495@cox.net.
5. Sessions may be changed or canceled by the Board of Governors due to lack of enrollment.
6. Sessions may be canceled due to testing, special events, weather, or technical problems at the rink. Club information will be posted on the bulletin boards near the entrances to the rinks. Also, updates will be posted on the WFS website, www.warwickfs.org. Check often for new information!
7. Music/Monitor fees are mandatory on all sessions as identified on page 4 (sessions Basics skaters may qualify for) and page 5 (Above Basics sessions). Attendance/Music reservations are assigned on a first come, first serve basis. The sooner your completed request is received, the better your chances are of getting your requested times and dates. The music fee will be deducted at the end of that session once volunteer requirements are met. **See page 6 for more information on the Music/Monitor policy and reservation process.**
8. Payments may be made to WFS in the form of check, money order or credit card. If paying by credit card, please fill out the bottom portion of page 3. Requests for changes in Above Basic sessions must be made in writing to Julie Cyr, Membership Chair by October 1, 2010. Requests for changes in Basics Programs sessions must be made in writing to Rita Bapties by November 1, 2010, or two weeks after start. After these dates, no refunds will be given.
9. If a bank returns a check to WFS, a \$25.00 fee will be added to your bill. Second offense will result in an additional \$25.00 fee and only bank checks or money orders will be accepted from that point forward.
10. All prior balances must be paid in full before the Fall/Winter application will be accepted.
11. Balances that are not paid within a reasonable time will be forwarded to USFS with the name of the skater as a member not in good standing. Members not in good standing will not be able to test or compete until their name is removed from the list. This applies to Full Members and Associate Members.
12. Preference will be given to applications of Full Members, then Associate Members and then Non-Members. Choose the appropriate membership option in the membership section of the application. A skater who buys on to a session must be an active USFS member in good standing.

SKATING SESSION DEFINITIONS AND CRITERIA

Basics Skaters Eligible Sessions

Power and Edges: Skaters must have passed PRE-PRELIMINARY MOVES IN THE FIELD to participate in this six week clinic. There are no upper level restrictions. Music fee does not apply. Begins 9/10/10.

Basic Skills Badges 1-8, Freeskate 1-4: All Basic Skills Programs have a 30-minute group lesson taught by professional instructors and an open skate for members only. Begins 10/16/10.

Basics Skills Camps: Mini Skills Camps will be conducted in three sessions with one session for CHOREOGRAPHY, one session for SPINS, and one session for JUMPS. Skaters must have passed Basic Skills Badge 6. Begins 10/17/10.

Basic Dance: Skaters must have passed BASIC BADGE 5. Learn rhythm, timing, expression and the steps and patterns for six dances. (Ice is shared with the Low Dance/Low MIF session). Music fee does not apply. Begins 10/29/10.

Basic 5+ Open Combined Restricted: Open to Freestyle, Moves in the Field and Dance. Skaters must have passed BASIC BADGE 4 to skate on this ice. Skaters working on FREESTYLE cannot have passed their JUVENILE FREESTYLE TEST. Skaters working on MOVES IN THE FIELD cannot have passed their JUVENILE MOVES IN THE FIELD TEST. Skaters working on DANCE cannot have passed all of their PRE-BRONZE DANCES. Open skate only, no group lesson. Private lesson optional, but recommended. Sorry, no harness can be used on this ice. Music fee of \$100.00 applies. Begins 9/11/10.

Freeskate 1+ Moves in the Field/Freestyle Restricted: Open to Freestyle, and Moves in the Field. Skaters must have passed BASIC BADGE 8 to skate on this ice. Skaters working on FREESTYLE cannot have passed their NOVICE FREESTYLE TEST. Skaters working on MOVES IN THE FIELD cannot have passed their NOVICE MOVES IN THE FIELD TEST. Music fee of \$100.00 applies. Begins 9/10/10

Missed Basics Skills Program scheduled lessons cannot be made up at another session.

Above Basics Sessions

Above Basics Open Combined: Open to Freestyle, Moves in the Field, and Dance. Skaters working on FREESTYLE or MOVES IN THE FIELD must have passed BASIC FREESKATE BADGE 4. Skaters working on DANCE must have passed BASIC DANCE BADGE 6. Music fee of \$100.00 applies.

Basic 5+ Open Combined Restricted: Open to Freestyle, Moves in the Field and Dance. Skaters must have passed BASIC BADGE 4 to skate on this ice. Skaters working on FREESTYLE cannot have passed their JUVENILE FREESTYLE TEST. Skaters working on MOVES IN THE FIELD cannot have passed their JUVENILE MOVES IN THE FIELD TEST. Skaters working on DANCE cannot have passed all of their PRE-BRONZE DANCES. Open skate only, no group lesson. Private lesson optional, but recommended. Sorry, no harness can be used on this ice. Music fee of \$100.00 applies.

Freeskate 1+ Moves in the Field/Freestyle Restricted: Open to Freestyle, and Moves in the Field. Skaters must have passed BASIC BADGE 8 to skate on this ice. Skaters working on FREESTYLE cannot have passed their NOVICE FREESTYLE TEST. Skaters working on MOVES IN THE FIELD cannot have passed their NOVICE MOVES IN THE FIELD TEST. Music fee of \$100.00 applies.

Low Dance/Low Moves in the Field: Skaters working on DANCE must have passed BASIC DANCE BADGE 6 and cannot have passed all PRE-BRONZE DANCES. Skaters working on MOVES cannot have passed their PRELIMINARY LEVEL MOVES IN THE FIELD TEST. (This ice is shared with the Basic Dance session). Music fee does not apply.

Open Moves and Freestyle: Open to Freestyle and Moves in the Field. Skaters must have passed BASIC FREESKATE BADGE 4. Music fee of \$100.00 applies.

Power and Edges: Skaters must have passed PRE-PRELIMINARY MOVES IN THE FIELD to participate in this six week clinic. There are no upper level restrictions. Music fee does not apply.

Adults are welcome to join any program for which they qualify.

All tests will be verified. No exceptions will be made for upper or lower restrictions.
